Poster presentation at ISAE 2017

Poster display and discussion is an important scientific part of the conference. We have done all we can to ensure that posters will get the optimal exposure. Posters will be displayed at the balcony of the conference centre, and all coffee/tea breaks will be close by. In addition, in the programme the presenters will have appointed times where they must stand by their poster.

PREPARING YOUR POSTER

To ensure your poster fits the board comfortably, your poster must be in the format ISO AO **Portrait size** (not landscape size). Landscape sized posters cannot be displayed.

Points to remember while designing your poster

- Delegates will often read your poster from a distance so all lettering should be sufficiently large and legible.
- Please do not include too much information.
- Text and figures should be designed to clearly convey the essence of your work. Details are best presented in a form that is easy to interpret visually, without too much text. We encourage you to use images, illustrations, figures, and graphs to illustrate your work.
- Each section of your presentation should have a descriptive heading; display the material in a logical sequence

Tips and hints

- A recent photo of the presenting author placed in one of the top corners of the poster will help delegates to identify you for discussion.
- A4 printouts of the poster are appreciated as handouts.
- Consider, if relevant, to bring a sound device or iPad with videos, when you are scheduled to stand by your poster to be able to provide more details about the study.

STUDENT POSTER COMPETITION

Students enrolled in institutions of higher education (Undergraduate, Master, PhD) can participate in the student poster competition for honor and prizes. The posters will be evaluated with regard to their scientific content and presentation quality. The price winner will be celebrated at the closing of the conference.

PLACING YOUR POSTER

Your poster will be assigned to a numbered poster board. We provide you with pins for mounting.

Boards will be ready for your use at the conference centre from 8 am on Tuesday 8 August. Please place your poster Tuesday between 8 and 9 am, and no later than noon; remove it shortly after the closing of the conference.
