8. Møllestien - a picturesque cobbled street right in the centre of Aarhus with small and unique houses from the 18th century.



Restaurants, cafés and cocktailbars:

Brunch: If you are looking for a brunch in Aarhus, there are many possibilities:

1. **Mefisto:** Mefisto in the Latin Quarter offers according to customers the best brunch in Aarhus. It is an untraditional brunch consisting of 7 courses served on a plank with two kinds of bread. The price is 198 DKK.

2. **Casablanca:** Another very famous brunch in Aarhus is at Casablanca near Mejlgade. The café offers a brunch buffet consisting of a wide range of freshly baked bread, eggs, salmon, chartcuteri, yoghurt and muesli, cheese, chocolate spreads, jam, pesto, fruits and vegetables. Furthermore all the coffee, tea and juice, you can drink is included. The price is 200 DKK.

Burgers:

Lately there has been a "boom" in burgerrestaurants in Aarhus.

1. **The Burger Shack**: The Burger Shack's burger is chosen as the best burger in Aarhus. Their SHACK BURGER costs 50 DKK, while a menu including fries and a soda costs 85 DKK.

Cocktails:

1. **St. Pauls Apothek:** The St. Pauls Apothek cocktail bar in Jægergårdsgade in the hip Frederiksbjerg city quarter creates international-class cocktails. St. Pauls Apothek, originally a chemist's, was established in 1899 by chemist Søren Holger Skouboe. Today the old chemist's shop houses its sixth generation of chemists. Maybe not your classic chemists, but their award-winning bartenders certainly serve innovative cocktails that can soothe all sorts of ailments.


5. Sota sushi: Quality sushi in the center of Aarhus.
