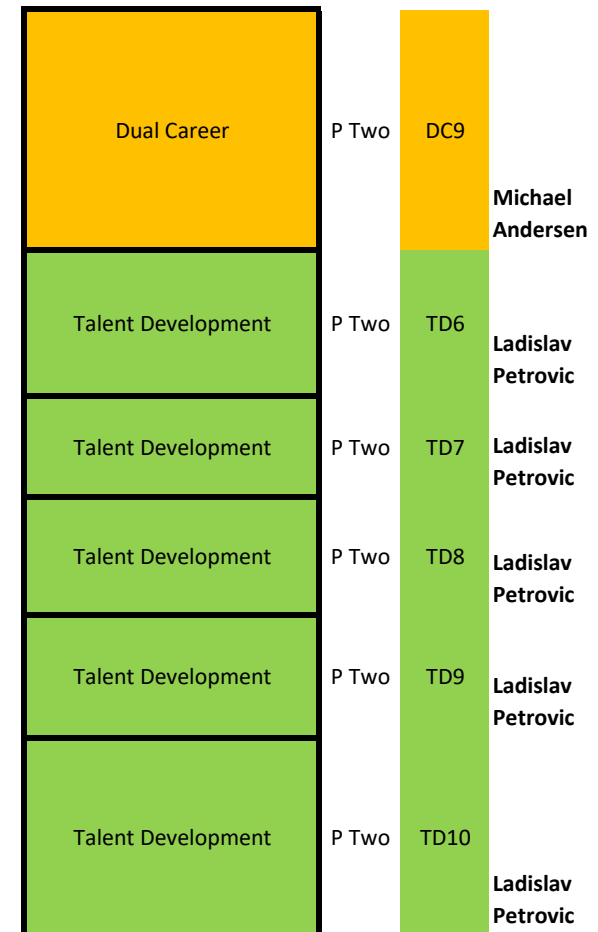

The Danish School Olympics
Values-themed sports turned into innovation and school pride

Born as a legacy of the IOC Session in Copenhagen 2009, the Danish School Olympics has experienced annual growth of 50 %. Initially an athletics-only values-themed competition with the objective to educate children about the Olympic values, the School Olympics has proven to be a driving force in innovating traditional sports, transforming the landscape of traditional sports. As we approach the 10 year anniversary of the School Olympics, cross-topic learning, school identity programmes and bridging to traditional sports will culminate as the School Olympic Cross Country Finals and the IAAF World Cross Country Championships merge in Aarhus in March 2019.
