

## **MEGA seminar 2017 - Publication Workshop for PhD students**

*This workshop is designed to facilitate Ph.D. students' ability to develop a conference paper into a manuscript that can be submitted for publication in an international scholarly journal.*

**Coordinators:** Karen Fog Olwig, University of Copenhagen, and Mikkel Rytter, Aarhus University

**Workshop I:** Each PhD student presents a paper in one of the sessions at the MEGA Seminar held at Sandbjerg, August 16-18, and receives critique from participants in the session. We expect this critique to be worked into the revised papers that are presented at workshop II. To help in this process, Karen and Mikkel will give a talk, during the MEGA Seminar (August 16, after dinner), in which they provide a few pointers, based on their own experiences, about the do's and don'ts of getting published in international journals.

**Workshop II:** On September 11 a workshop for the presentation of the revised papers will be held in Copenhagen. In preparation for this workshop students should identify an international journal where they plan to publish their paper and the revised conference paper should be directed toward the academic profile of this journal and its readership. At the workshop students will make a brief oral presentation outlining how the paper has been revised in the light of critique received at the MEGA seminar and the specific profile and guidelines of the journal. Each student will also be expected to prepare a critique of two manuscripts revised for publication by fellow students.

In the weeks following this workshop, revision of the manuscripts should be completed in consultation with the students' advisors and submitted to the chosen journal.

**ECTS:** 3, upon submission of the manuscript to an academic journal.

No reading is required for this workshop.
