She holds an MSc in Global Politics from the London School of Economics and Political Science.

What is the Purpose of your Talk?

To provide a brief overview of TSM – *Towards Sustainable Mining* – a global mining sustainability standard that helps companies manage social and environmental risks.

Abstract:

TSM has been helping mine sites manage, report, and verify their sustainability performance since 2004. Today, more than 200 mining companies around the world implement the TSM program, which sets rigorous standards for environmental and social risks, such as tailings management, water stewardship, and relationships with Indigenous peoples. The program is currently implemented in several Arctic jurisdictions, including Canada, Finland, and Norway. The aim of this talk is to improve awareness of this widely adopted standard for sustainability in the mining sector.
